Mr. NELSON of Nebraska introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To amend the Public Rangelands Improvement Act of 1978 to establish criteria for the rate of fees charged for grazing private livestock on public rangelands.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GRAZING ON PUBLIC RANGELANDS.**

4 Section 6 of the Public Rangelands Improvement Act
5 of 1978 (43 U.S.C. 1905) is amended—

6 (1) by striking the section heading and all that
7 follows through “(a) For the” and inserting the fol-
8 lowing:

1 **“SEC. 6. GRAZING FEES.**

2 “(a) ESTABLISHMENT OF FEES.—

3 “(1) IN GENERAL.—For the”; and

4 (2) in subsection (a), by adding at the end the
5 following:

6 “(2) GRAZING ON PUBLIC RANGELANDS.—

7 When establishing fees for grazing private livestock
8 on public rangelands, the Secretary (with respect to
9 land managed by the Bureau of Land Management
10 (including land held for the benefit of an Indian
11 tribe)) and the Secretary of Agriculture (with re-
12 spect to National Forest System land) shall set the
13 rate at a level that is comparable to the rate charged
14 by private landowners in the area or region, as de-
15 termined by the applicable Secretary.”.
