CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of the Capitol Grounds for the Greater
Washington Soap Box Derby.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. USE OF CAPITOL GROUNDS FOR SOAP BOX**
4 **DERBY RACES.**

5 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—The Greater Washington Soap
6 Box Derby Association (in this resolution referred to as
7 the “sponsor”) shall be permitted to sponsor a public
8 event, soap box derby races (in this resolution referred to
9 as the “event”), on the Capitol Grounds.

10 (b) **DATE OF EVENT.**—The event shall be held on
11 June 14, 2014, or on such other date as the Speaker of
12 the House of Representatives and the Committee on Rules
13 and Administration of the Senate jointly designate.

14 **SEC. 2. TERMS AND CONDITIONS.**

15 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Under conditions to be prescribed
16 by the Architect of the Capitol and the Capitol Police
17 Board, the event shall be—

18 (1) free of admission charge and open to the
19 public; and

20 (2) arranged not to interfere with the needs of
21 Congress.

22 (b) **EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES.**—The sponsor shall
23 assume full responsibility for all expenses and liabilities
24 incident to all activities associated with the event.

1 **SEC. 3. EVENT PREPARATIONS.**

2 Subject to the approval of the Architect of the Cap-
3 itol, the sponsor is authorized to erect upon the Capitol
4 Grounds such stage, sound amplification devices, and
5 other related structures and equipment as may be required
6 for the event.

7 **SEC. 4. ADDITIONAL ARRANGEMENTS.**

8 The Architect of the Capitol and the Capitol Police
9 Board are authorized to make such additional arrange-
10 ments as may be required to carry out the event.

11 **SEC. 5. ENFORCEMENT OF RESTRICTIONS.**

12 The Capitol Police Board shall provide for enforce-
13 ment of the restrictions contained in section 5104(c) of
14 title 40, United States Code, concerning sales, advertise-
15 ments, displays, and solicitations on the Capitol Grounds,
16 as well as other restrictions applicable to the Capitol
17 Grounds, with respect to the event.
