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## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of the Capitol Grounds for the National Peace Officers Memorial Service and the National Honor Guard and Pipe Band Exhibition.

- 1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
- 2 *concurring),*

1 **SECTION 1. USE OF THE CAPITOL GROUNDS FOR NA-**  
2 **TIONAL PEACE OFFICERS MEMORIAL SERV-**  
3 **ICE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Grand Lodge of the Fra-  
5 ternal Order of Police and its auxiliary shall be permitted  
6 to sponsor a public event, the 33rd Annual National Peace  
7 Officers Memorial Service (in this resolution referred to  
8 as the “Memorial Service”), on the Capitol Grounds, in  
9 order to honor the law enforcement officers who died in  
10 the line of duty during 2013.

11 (b) DATE OF MEMORIAL SERVICE.—The Memorial  
12 Service shall be held on May 15, 2014, or on such other  
13 date as the Speaker of the House of Representatives and  
14 the Committee on Rules and Administration of the Senate  
15 jointly designate, with preparation for the event to begin  
16 on May 12, 2014.

17 **SEC. 2. USE OF THE CAPITOL GROUNDS FOR NATIONAL**  
18 **HONOR GUARD AND PIPE BAND EXHIBITION.**

19 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Grand Lodge of the Fra-  
20 ternal Order of Police and its auxiliary shall be permitted  
21 to sponsor a public event, the National Honor Guard and  
22 Pipe Band Exhibition (in this resolution referred to as the  
23 “Exhibition”), on the Capitol Grounds, in order to allow  
24 law enforcement representatives to exhibit their ability to  
25 demonstrate Honor Guard programs and provide for a bag  
26 pipe exhibition.

1           (b) DATE OF EXHIBITION.—The exhibition shall be  
2 held on May 14, 2014, or on such other date as the Speak-  
3 er of the House of Representatives and the Committee on  
4 Rules and Administration of the Senate jointly designate.

5 **SEC. 3. TERMS AND CONDITIONS.**

6           (a) IN GENERAL.—Under conditions to be prescribed  
7 by the Architect of the Capitol and the Capitol Police  
8 Board, the event shall be—

9                   (1) free of admission charge and open to the  
10 public; and

11                   (2) arranged not to interfere with the needs of  
12 Congress.

13           (b) EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES.—The sponsors of  
14 the Memorial Service and Exhibition shall assume full re-  
15 sponsibility for all expenses and liabilities incident to all  
16 activities associated with the events.

17 **SEC. 4. EVENT PREPARATIONS.**

18           Subject to the approval of the Architect of the Cap-  
19 itol, the sponsors referred to in section 3(b) are authorized  
20 to erect upon the Capitol Grounds such stage, sound am-  
21 plification devices, and other related structures and equip-  
22 ment, as may be required for the Memorial Service and  
23 Exhibition.

1 **SEC. 5. ENFORCEMENT OF RESTRICTIONS.**

2       The Capitol Police Board shall provide for enforce-  
3 ment of the restrictions contained in section 5104(c) of  
4 title 40, United States Code, concerning sales, advertise-  
5 ments, displays, and solicitations on the Capitol Grounds,  
6 as well as other restrictions applicable to the Capitol  
7 Grounds, in connection with the events.



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
