

In the Senate of the United States,

August 1, 2014.

Resolved, That the resolution from the House of Representatives (H.J. Res. 76) entitled “Joint resolution making continuing appropriations for the National Nuclear Security Administration for fiscal year 2014, and for other purposes.”, do pass with the following

AMENDMENTS:

Strike all after the first word, and insert:

1 the following sum is appropriated, out of any money
2 in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the fiscal
3 year ending September 30, 2014, and for other purposes,
4 namely:

5 *DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE*

6 *PROCUREMENT*

7 *PROCUREMENT, DEFENSE-WIDE*

8 *For an additional amount for “Procurement, Defense-*
9 *Wide”, \$225,000,000, to remain available until September*

1 30, 2015, which shall be for the Secretary of Defense to pro-
 2 vide to the Government of Israel for the procurement of the
 3 Iron Dome defense system to counter short-range rocket
 4 threats: Provided, That such funds shall be transferred im-
 5 mediately only through an exchange of letters to address
 6 emergent operations in support of Operation Protective
 7 Edge, notwithstanding section 3.1.3.2.1 of the U.S.-Israel
 8 Iron Dome Procurement Agreement: Provided further, That
 9 nothing in this paragraph shall be construed to apply to
 10 previously appropriated funds for the procurement of Iron
 11 Dome: Provided further, That such amount is designated
 12 by the Congress as an emergency requirement pursuant to
 13 section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budget and Emer-
 14 gency Deficit Control Act of 1985.

15 This joint resolution may be cited as the “Emergency
 16 Supplemental Appropriations Resolution, 2014”.

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill making an emergency supplemental appropriation for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, to provide funding to Israel for the Iron Dome defense system to counter short-range rocket threats.”.
