Ms. NORTON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform

A BILL

To amend the District of Columbia Home Rule Act to provide that the District of Columbia Treasurer or one of the Deputy Chief Financial Officers of the Office of the Chief Financial Officer of the District of Columbia may perform the functions and duties of the Office in an acting capacity if there is a vacancy in the Office.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “District of Columbia
5 Chief Financial Officer Vacancy Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZING DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA TREASURER**
2 **OR DEPUTY CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER OF**
3 **OFFICE OF CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER OF**
4 **THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA TO SERVE AS**
5 **ACTING CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER IN**
6 **EVENT OF VACANCY IN OFFICE.**

7 (a) AUTHORIZING SERVICE IN ACTING CAPACITY IN
8 EVENT OF VACANCY IN OFFICE.—Section 424(b) of the
9 District of Columbia Home Rule Act (sec. 1–204.24(b),
10 D.C. Official Code) is amended by adding at the end the
11 following new paragraph:

12 “(3) AUTHORIZING TREASURER OR DEPUTY
13 CFO TO PERFORM DUTIES IN ACTING CAPACITY IN
14 EVENT OF VACANCY IN OFFICE.—

15 “(A) SERVICE AS CFO.—

16 “(i) IN GENERAL.—Except as pro-
17 vided in clause (ii), if there is a vacancy in
18 the Office of Chief Financial Officer be-
19 cause the Chief Financial Officer has died,
20 resigned, or is otherwise unable to perform
21 the functions and duties of the Office—

22 “(I) the District of Columbia
23 Treasurer shall serve as the Chief Fi-
24 nancial Officer in an acting capacity,
25 subject to the time limitation of sub-
26 paragraph (B); or

1 “(II) the Mayor may direct one
2 of the Deputy Chief Financial Officers
3 of the Office referred to in subpara-
4 graphs (A) through (D) of subsection
5 (a)(3) to serve as the Chief Financial
6 Officer in an acting capacity, subject
7 to the time limitation of subparagraph
8 (B).

9 “(ii) EXCLUSION OF CERTAIN INDI-
10 VIDUALS.—Notwithstanding clause (i), an
11 individual may not serve as the Chief Fi-
12 nancial Officer under such clause if the in-
13 dividual did not serve as the District of
14 Columbia Treasurer or as one of such Dep-
15 uty Chief Financial Officers of the Office
16 of the Chief Financial Officer (as the case
17 may be) for at least 90 days during the 1-
18 year period which ends on the date the va-
19 cancy occurs.

20 “(B) TIME LIMITATION.—A vacancy in the
21 Office of the Chief Financial Officer may not be
22 filled by the service of any individual in an act-
23 ing capacity under subparagraph (A) after the
24 expiration of the 210-day period which begins
25 on the date the vacancy occurs.”.

1 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section
2 424(b)(2)(D) of such Act (sec. 1–204.24(b)(2)(D), D.C.
3 Official Code) is amended by striking “Any vacancy” and
4 inserting “Subject to paragraph (3), any vacancy”.

5 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
6 this Act shall apply with respect to vacancies occurring
7 on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
