3 **SECTION 1. LANCE CORPORAL JOSHUA B. MCDANIELS AND**
4 **VETERANS MEMORIAL POST OFFICE BUILD-**
5 **ING.**

6 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
7 Postal Service located at 25 South Oak Street in London,

1 Ohio, shall be known and designated as the “Lance Cor-
2 poral Joshua B. McDaniels and Veterans Memorial Post
3 Office Building”.

4 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
5 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
6 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
7 be deemed to be a reference to the “Lance Corporal Josh-
8 ua B. McDaniels and Veterans Memorial Post Office
9 Building”.
