## A BILL

To impose a moratorium on conferences held by the Internal  
Revenue Service.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Stop Playing on Citi-  
5       zen’s Cash Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. MORATORIUM ON IRS CONFERENCES.**

7       The Internal Revenue Service shall not hold any con-  
8       ference until—

9               (1) the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Ad-  
10       ministration submits a report to Congress—

1           (A) certifying that the Internal Revenue  
2           Service has implemented all of the recommenda-  
3           tions set out in such Inspector General’s report  
4           titled “Review of the August 2010 Small Busi-  
5           ness/Self-Employed Division’s Conference in  
6           Anaheim, California”, and  
7           (B) describing such implementation, and  
8           (2) the Internal Revenue Service is authorized  
9           by law (enacted after the date of the enactment of  
10          this Act) to resume holding conferences.
