A BILL

To provide for the termination of employment of employees of the Internal Revenue Service who take certain official actions for political purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop Targeting Our
5 Politics IRS Act” or as the “STOP IRS Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT OF INTERNAL REV-**
2 **ENUE SERVICE EMPLOYEES FOR TAKING OF-**
3 **FICIAL ACTIONS FOR POLITICAL PURPOSES.**

4 Paragraph (10) of section 1203(b) of the Internal
5 Revenue Service Restructuring and Reform Act of 1998
6 is amended to read as follows:

7 “(10) performing, delaying, or failing to per-
8 form (or threatening to perform, delay, or fail to
9 perform) any official action (including any audit)
10 with respect to a taxpayer for purpose of extracting
11 personal gain or benefit or for a political purpose.”.

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
