

In the Senate of the United States,

May 22, 2014.

Resolved, That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 316) entitled “An Act to reinstate and transfer certain hydroelectric licenses and extend the deadline for commencement of construction of certain hydroelectric projects.”, do pass with the following

AMENDMENT:

Strike out all after the enacting clause and insert:

1 ***SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.***

2 *This Act may be cited as the “Collinsville Renewable*
3 *Energy Production Act”.*

4 ***SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.***

5 *In this Act:*

6 (1) *COMMISSION.*—*The term “Commission”*
7 *means the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.*

8 (2) *LICENSE.*—*The term “license” means—*

9 (A) *the license for Commission project num-*
10 *ber 10822;*

1 (B) the license for Commission project num-
2 ber 10823; or

3 (C) both.

4 (3) TOWN.—The term “Town” means the town of
5 Canton, Connecticut.

6 **SEC. 3. REINSTATEMENT, EXTENSION, AND TRANSFER OF**
7 **EXPIRED LICENSES.**

8 Notwithstanding the termination of the license, the
9 Commission may, at the request of the Town, in accordance
10 with section 4(a), and after reasonable notice—

11 (1) reinstate the licence;

12 (2) extend for 2 years after the date on which the
13 license is reinstated the time period during which the
14 licensee is required to commence the construction of
15 the project subject to the license; and

16 (3) subject to section 4, transfer the license to the
17 Town.

18 **SEC. 4. CONDITIONS OF TRANSFER.**

19 (a) APPLICATION FOR TRANSFER.—The Town may re-
20 quest the reinstatement, extension, and transfer of the li-
21 cense by filing an application for approval of the transfer.

22 (b) CONTENTS OF APPLICATION.—The application for
23 approval of the transfer shall set forth in appropriate detail
24 the qualifications of the Town to hold the license and to
25 operate the property under license, which qualifications

1 *shall be the same as those required of applicants for the*
2 *license.*

3 (c) *COMMISSION APPROVAL.—The Commission may*
4 *approve the transfer on a showing that the transfer is in*
5 *the public interest.*

6 (d) *TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF LICENSES.—The*
7 *Town shall be subject to—*

8 (1) *all the conditions of the license and all the*
9 *provisions and conditions of the Federal Power Act*
10 *(16 U.S.C. 791a et seq.), as though the Town were the*
11 *original licensee; and*

12 (2) *any additional terms and conditions the*
13 *Commission determines to be necessary, including*
14 *conditions for the protection, mitigation, and en-*
15 *hancement of fish and wildlife and related habitat*
16 *under sections 10(j) and 18 of the Federal Power Act*
17 *(16 U.S.C. 803(j), 811).*

18 **SEC. 5. ADMINISTRATION.**

19 *The Commission shall supplement the environmental*
20 *impact statement or similar analysis required under the*
21 *National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (42 U.S.C.*
22 *4321 et seq.) prepared in connection with the issuance of*
23 *the original license to examine all new circumstances and*
24 *information relevant to environmental concerns and bear-*

- 1 *ing on the reinstatement of the license or the impact of the*
- 2 *license.*
