A BILL

To amend the Continuing Appropriations Resolution, 2013 (Public Law 112–175) to permit research on firearms safety and gun violence.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 The Act may be cited as the “Firearm Safety and
5 Public Health Research Act of 2013”.

1 **SEC. 2. PERMITTING THE USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS FOR RE-**
2 **SEARCH ON FIREARMS SAFETY AND GUN VIO-**
3 **LENCE.**

4 The Continuing Appropriations Resolution, 2013
5 (Public Law 112–175) is amended by inserting after sec-
6 tion 155 the following:

7 “SEC. 156. Notwithstanding section 101, sections
8 218 and 503(e) of division F of the Consolidated Appro-
9 priations Act, 2012 (Public Law 112–74) shall not apply
10 to amounts made available by this joint resolution insofar
11 as such sections relate to any activity to conduct research
12 on firearms safety or gun violence.”.
