A BILL

To provide for the compensation of furloughed Federal employees.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Federal Employee Ret-
5 roactive Pay Fairness Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. COMPENSATION FOR FURLOUGHED FEDERAL EM-**
2 **PLLOYEES.**

3 Federal employees furloughed as a result of any lapse
4 in appropriations which begins on or about October 1,
5 2013, shall be compensated at their standard rate of com-
6 pensation, for the period of such lapse in appropriations,
7 as soon as practicable after such lapse in appropriations
8 ends.
