Mr. GRIFFIN of Arkansas introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform

A BILL

To provide for the compensation of any Federal, State, or local employee furloughed due to a lapse in appropriations which began on or about October 1, 2013.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COMPENSATION FOR FURLOUGHED EMPLOY-**
4 **EES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Any Federal employee or State or
6 local employee furloughed due to a lapse in appropriations
7 (from the Treasury of the United States) which began on
8 or about October 1, 2013, shall be compensated at such
9 employee’s standard rate of compensation, for the period

1 of such lapse in appropriations, as soon as practicable
2 after such lapse in appropriations ends.

3 (b) DEFINITIONS.—For purposes of this Act—

4 (1) the term “Federal employee” means an em-
5 ployee as defined by section 2105 of title 5, United
6 States Code;

7 (2) the term “State or local employee” means
8 an individual employed by the government of a
9 State, municipality, or other political subdivision of
10 a State, or by the government of the District of Co-
11 lumbia, whose principal employment is in connection
12 with an activity which is financed in whole or in part
13 by loans or grants made by the United States; and

14 (3) the term “State” means a State or territory
15 or possession of the United States.
