A BILL

To amend the Act of October 19, 1973, concerning taxable income to members of the Grand Portage Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Grand Portage Band
5 Per Capita Adjustment Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EQUAL TREATMENT OF CERTAIN PER CAPITA IN-**
7 **COME FOR PURPOSES OF FEDERAL ASSIST-**
8 **ANCE.**

9 Paragraph (4) of section 7 of the Act of October 19,
10 1973 (25 U.S.C. 1407(4)) is amended by striking “pursu-
11 ant to the agreements of such Band” and inserting “or
12 the Grand Portage Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indi-
13 ans, or both, pursuant to the agreements of each Band”.

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
