3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Health Care
5 Providers from Increased Administrative Burdens Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. NON-FEDERAL CONTRACTOR STATUS FOR ENTITIES**
2 **RECEIVING CERTAIN HEALTH CARE-RE-**
3 **LATED FEDERAL PAYMENTS.**

4 A State, a local government, or other recipient that
5 receives a payment from the Federal Government, directly
6 or indirectly and regardless of reimbursement method-
7 ology, related to the delivery of health care services to indi-
8 viduals, whether or not such individuals are or have been
9 employed by the Federal Government, shall not be treated
10 as a Federal contractor or subcontractor by the Office of
11 Federal Contract Compliance Programs based on the work
12 performed or actions taken by such individuals that re-
13 sulted in the receipt of such payments.
