## A BILL

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 218–10 Merrick Boulevard in Springfield Gardens, New York, as the “Cynthia Jenkins Post Office Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CYNTHIA JENKINS POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
5 Postal Service located at 218–10 Merrick Boulevard in

1 Springfield Gardens, New York, shall be known and des-  
2 ignated as the “Cynthia Jenkins Post Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Cynthia Jenkins Post  
7 Office Building”.
