## A BILL

To amend the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act to repeal the requirement to establish catch limits for the Gulf of Mexico red snapper fishery.

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Supporting New Ave-  
5       nues to Protect Our Fishermen’s Resources Act” or the  
6       “SNAPR Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF CATCH LIMITS REQUIREMENT FOR**  
2 **GULF OF MEXICO RED SNAPPER FISHERY.**

3 Subsection (d) of section 407 of the Magnuson-Ste-  
4 vens Fishery Conservation and Management Act (16  
5 U.S.C. 1884) is repealed.
