1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Business Risk Mitiga-
- 3 tion and Price Stabilization Act of 2013".
- 4 SEC. 2. MARGIN REQUIREMENTS.
- 5 (a) Commodity Exchange Act Amendment.—
- 6 Section 4s(e) of the Commodity Exchange Act (7 U.S.C.
- 7 6s(e)), as added by section 731 of the Dodd-Frank Wall
- 8 Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, is amended
- 9 by adding at the end the following new paragraph:
- 10 "(4) Applicability with respect to
- 11 COUNTERPARTIES.—The requirements of paragraphs
- 12 (2)(A)(ii) and (2)(B)(ii), including the initial and
- variation margin requirements imposed by rules
- adopted pursuant to paragraphs (2)(A)(ii) and
- 15 (2)(B)(ii), shall not apply to a swap in which a
- 16 counterparty qualifies for an exception under section
- 2(h)(7)(A), or an exemption issued under section
- 18 4(c)(1) from the requirements of section 2(h)(1)(A)
- 19 for cooperative entities as defined in such exemption,
- or satisfies the criteria in section 2(h)(7)(D).".

- 22 Section 15F(e) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934

- 25 tion Act, is amended by adding at the end the following

6	criteria in section $3C(g)(4)$.".				
7	SEC. 3. IMPLEMENTATION.				
8	The amendments made by this Act to the Commodity				
9	Exchange Act shall be implemented—				
10	(1) without regard to—				
11	(A) chapter 35 of title 44, United States				
12	Code; and				
13	(B) the notice and comment provisions of				
14	section 553 of title 5, United States Code;				
15	(2) through the promulgation of an interim				
16	final rule, pursuant to which public comment will be				
17	sought before a final rule is issued; and				
18	(3) such that paragraph (1) shall apply solely				
19	to changes to rules and regulations, or proposed

- rectly a consequence of such amendments.
