A BILL

To require the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency to use the commercially available volume of cellulosic biofuel in setting requirements for the renewable fuel program under the Clean Air Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO THE CLEAN AIR ACT.**

4 Section 211(o)(7)(D)(i) of the Clean Air Act (42
5 U.S.C. 7545(o)(7)(D)(i)) is amended—

1 (1) by striking “, as determined by the Admin-
2 istrator based on the estimate provided under para-
3 graph (3)(A)”;

4 (2) by striking “the Administrator may also re-
5 duce” and inserting “the Administrator shall also
6 reduce”; and

7 (3) by inserting “For purposes of this subpara-
8 graph, the projected volume of cellulosic biofuel pro-
9 duction for a calendar year shall not be more than
10 5 percent or 1 million gallons (whichever is greater)
11 more than the total volume of cellulosic biofuel that
12 was commercially available for the most recent cal-
13 endar year for which such total volume is known.”
14 after “by the same or a lesser volume.”.

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
