Mr. BISHOP of Utah, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 678) to authorize all Bureau of Reclamation conduit facilities for hydropower development under Federal Reclamation law, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the State of the Union for consid-
5 eration of the bill (H.R. 678) to authorize all Bureau of

1 Reclamation conduit facilities for hydropower development
2 under Federal Reclamation law, and for other purposes.
3 The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All
4 points of order against consideration of the bill are waived.
5 General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not
6 exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair
7 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Nat-
8 ural Resources. After general debate the bill shall be con-
9 sidered for amendment under the five-minute rule. The bill
10 shall be considered as read. All points of order against
11 provisions in the bill are waived. No amendment to the
12 bill shall be in order except: (1) those received for printing
13 in the portion of the Congressional Record designated for
14 that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII dated at least one
15 day before the day of consideration of the amendment; and
16 (2) pro forma amendments for the purpose of debate.
17 Each amendment so received may be offered only by the
18 Member who caused it to be printed or a designee and
19 shall be considered as read if printed. At the conclusion
20 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
21 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
22 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
23 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
24 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening

- 1 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
- 2 structions.
