## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1406) to amend the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to provide compensatory time for employees in the private sector.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.  
3 1406) to amend the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938  
4 to provide compensatory time for employees in the private  
5 sector. All points of order against consideration of the bill  
6 are waived. The amendment in the nature of a substitute  
7 recommended by the Committee on Education and the

1 Workforce now printed in the bill shall be considered as  
2 adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as read.  
3 All points of order against provisions in the bill, as amend-  
4 ed, are waived. The previous question shall be considered  
5 as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further  
6 amendment thereto, to final passage without intervening  
7 motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and  
8 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of  
9 the Committee on Education and the Workforce; (2) the  
10 further amendment printed in the report of the Committee  
11 on Rules accompanying this resolution, if offered by Rep-  
12 resentative Gibson of New York or his designee, which  
13 shall be in order without intervention of any point of  
14 order, shall be considered as read, shall be separately de-  
15 batable for 10 minutes equally divided and controlled by  
16 the proponent and an opponent, and shall not be subject  
17 to a demand for division of the question; and (3) one mo-  
18 tion to recommit with or without instructions.
