2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 45) to repeal the Patient Protection and Affordable Care
4 Act and health care-related provisions in the Health Care
5 and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010. All points of
6 order against consideration of the bill are waived. The

1 amendment printed in the report of the Committee on
2 Rules accompanying this resolution shall be considered as
3 adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as read.
4 All points of order against provisions in the bill, as amend-
5 ed, are waived. The previous question shall be considered
6 as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any amendment
7 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except:
8 (1) two hours of debate equally divided among and con-
9 trolled by the respective chairs and ranking minority mem-
10 bers of the Committees on Education and the Workforce,
11 Energy and Commerce, and Ways and Means; and (2) one
12 motion to recommit with or without instructions.
