Mr. WEBSTER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3) to approve the construction, operation, and maintenance of the Keystone XL pipeline, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3) to approve the construction, op-
6 eration, and maintenance of the Keystone XL pipeline,
7 and for other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall

1 be dispensed with. All points of order against consider-
2 ation of the bill are waived. General debate shall be con-
3 fined to the bill and shall not exceed 90 minutes equally
4 divided among and controlled by the respective chairs and
5 ranking minority members of the Committees on Trans-
6 portation and Infrastructure, Energy and Commerce, and
7 Natural Resources. After general debate the bill shall be
8 considered for amendment under the five-minute rule. In
9 lieu of the amendments in the nature of a substitute rec-
10 ommended by the Committees on Transportation and In-
11 frastructure, Energy and Commerce, and Natural Re-
12 sources now printed in the bill, it shall be in order to con-
13 sider as an original bill for the purpose of amendment
14 under the five-minute rule an amendment in the nature
15 of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Committee
16 Print 113–11. That amendment in the nature of a sub-
17 stitute shall be considered as read. All points of order
18 against that amendment in the nature of a substitute are
19 waived. No amendment to that amendment in the nature
20 of a substitute shall be in order except those printed in
21 the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this
22 resolution. Each such amendment may be offered only in
23 the order printed in the report, may be offered only by
24 a Member designated in the report, shall be considered
25 as read, shall be debatable for the time specified in the

1 report equally divided and controlled by the proponent and
2 an opponent, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall
3 not be subject to a demand for division of the question
4 in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. All points
5 of order against such amendments are waived. At the con-
6 clusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the
7 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with
8 such amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member
9 may demand a separate vote in the House on any amend-
10 ment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill
11 or to the amendment in the nature of a substitute made
12 in order as original text. The previous question shall be
13 considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto
14 to final passage without intervening motion except one
15 motion to recommit with or without instructions.
