Mr. BURGESS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2609) making appropriations for energy and water development and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2609) making appropriations for
6 energy and water development and related agencies for the

1 fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, and for other pur-
2 poses. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with.
3 All points of order against consideration of the bill are
4 waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and
5 shall not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled
6 by the chair and ranking minority member of the Com-
7 mittee on Appropriations. After general debate the bill
8 shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute
9 rule. Points of order against provisions in the bill for fail-
10 ure to comply with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived. Dur-
11 ing consideration of the bill for amendment, the chair of
12 the Committee of the Whole may accord priority in rec-
13 ognition on the basis of whether the Member offering an
14 amendment has caused it to be printed in the portion of
15 the Congressional Record designated for that purpose in
16 clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed shall be
17 considered as read. When the committee rises and reports
18 the bill back to the House with a recommendation that
19 the bill do pass, the previous question shall be considered
20 as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final
21 passage without intervening motion except one motion to
22 recommit with or without instructions.
