Mr. BISHOP of Utah, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1459) to ensure that the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 applies to the declaration of national monuments, and for other purposes, and providing for consideration of motions to suspend the rules.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after adoption of this reso-
2 lution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule
3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of
4 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-

1 ation of the bill (H.R. 1459) to ensure that the National
2 Environmental Policy Act of 1969 applies to the declara-
3 tion of national monuments, and for other purposes. The
4 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points
5 of order against consideration of the bill are waived. Gen-
6 eral debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not ex-
7 ceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair
8 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Nat-
9 ural Resources. After general debate the bill shall be con-
10 sidered for amendment under the five-minute rule. The bill
11 shall be considered as read. All points of order against
12 provisions in the bill are waived. No amendment to the
13 bill shall be in order except those printed in the report
14 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution.
15 Each such amendment may be offered only in the order
16 printed in the report, may be offered only by a Member
17 designated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall
18 be debatable for the time specified in the report equally
19 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,
20 shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be sub-
21 ject to a demand for division of the question in the House
22 or in the Committee of the Whole. All points of order
23 against such amendments are waived. At the conclusion
24 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
25 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such

1 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
2 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
3 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
4 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
5 structions.

6 SEC. 2. It shall be in order at any time on the legisla-
7 tive day of March 27, 2014, for the Speaker to entertain
8 motions that the House suspend the rules, as though
9 under clause 1 of rule XV, relating to the following: (a)
10 a measure addressing the Medicare payment system for
11 physicians; and (b) a measure addressing Ukraine.

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
