## RESOLUTION

Relating to the consideration of House Report 113–415 and an accompanying resolution, and providing for consideration of the resolution (H. Res. 565) calling on Attorney General Eric H. Holder, Jr., to appoint a special counsel to investigate the targeting of conservative nonprofit groups by the Internal Revenue Service.

- 1       *Resolved*, That if House Report 113–415 is called up
- 2 by direction of the Committee on Oversight and Govern-

1 ment Reform: (a) all points of order against the report  
2 are waived and the report shall be considered as read; and

3 (b)(1) an accompanying resolution offered by direc-  
4 tion of the Committee on Oversight and Government Re-  
5 form shall be considered as read and shall not be subject  
6 to a point of order; and

7 (2) the previous question shall be considered as or-  
8 dered on such resolution to adoption without intervening  
9 motion or demand for division of the question except: (i)  
10 50 minutes of debate equally divided and controlled by the  
11 chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on  
12 Oversight and Government Reform or their respective des-  
13 ignees; (ii) after conclusion of debate one motion to refer  
14 if offered by Representative Cummings of Maryland or his  
15 designee which shall be separately debatable for 10 min-  
16 utes equally divided and controlled by the proponent and  
17 an opponent; and (iii) one motion to recommit with or  
18 without instructions.

19 SEC. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be  
20 in order without intervention of any point of order to con-  
21 sider in the House the resolution (H. Res. 565) calling  
22 on Attorney General Eric H. Holder, Jr., to appoint a spe-  
23 cial counsel to investigate the targeting of conservative  
24 nonprofit groups by the Internal Revenue Service. The  
25 resolution shall be considered as read. The previous ques-

1 tion shall be considered as ordered on the resolution to  
2 adoption without intervening motion or demand for divi-  
3 sion of the question except 40 minutes of debate equally  
4 divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority  
5 member of the Committee on the Judiciary.
