Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4660) making appropriations for the Departments of Commerce and Justice, Science, and Related Agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2015, and for other purposes; and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4435) to authorize appropriations for fiscal year 2015 for military activities of the Department of Defense and for military construction, to prescribe military personnel strengths for such fiscal year, and for other purposes.

Mr. WOODALL, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4660) making appropriations for the Departments of Commerce and Justice, Science, and Related Agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2015, and for other purposes; and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4435) to authorize appropriations for fiscal year 2015 for military activities of the Department of Defense and for military construction, to prescribe military personnel strengths for such fiscal year, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after adoption of this reso-
2 lution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule
3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of
4 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4660) making appropriations for
6 the Departments of Commerce and Justice, Science, and
7 Related Agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30,
8 2015, and for other purposes. The first reading of the bill
9 shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consid-
10 eration of the bill are waived. General debate shall be con-
11 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-
12 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
13 member of the Committee on Appropriations. After gen-
14 eral debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
15 under the five-minute rule. Points of order against provi-
16 sions in the bill for failure to comply with clause 2 of rule
17 XXI are waived. During consideration of the bill for
18 amendment, the chair of the Committee of the Whole may
19 accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether the
20 Member offering an amendment has caused it to be print-
21 ed in the portion of the Congressional Record designated
22 for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments
23 so printed shall be considered as read. When the com-
24 mittee rises and reports the bill back to the House with
25 a recommendation that the bill do pass, the previous ques-

1 tion shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amend-
2 ments thereto to final passage without intervening motion
3 except one motion to recommit with or without instruc-
4 tions.

5 SEC. 2. At any time after adoption of this resolution
6 the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule XVIII,
7 declare the House resolved into the Committee of the
8 Whole House on the state of the Union for consideration
9 of the bill (H.R. 4435) to authorize appropriations for fis-
10 cal year 2015 for military activities of the Department of
11 Defense and for military construction, to prescribe mili-
12 tary personnel strengths for such fiscal year, and for other
13 purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed
14 with. All points of order against consideration of the bill
15 are waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill
16 and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-
17 trolled by the chair and ranking minority member of the
18 Committee on Armed Services. After general debate the
19 bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
20 minute rule. In lieu of the amendment in the nature of
21 a substitute recommended by the Committee on Armed
22 Services now printed in the bill, an amendment in the na-
23 ture of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Com-
24 mittee Print 113-44 shall be considered as adopted in the
25 House and in the Committee of the Whole. The bill, as

1 amended, shall be considered as the original bill for the
2 purpose of further amendment under the five-minute rule
3 and shall be considered as read. All points of order against
4 provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. No further
5 amendment to the bill, as amended, shall be in order ex-
6 cept those printed in the report of the Committee on Rules
7 accompanying this resolution. Each such further amend-
8 ment may be offered only in the order printed in the re-
9 port, may be offered only by a Member designated in the
10 report, shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for
11 the time specified in the report equally divided and con-
12 trolled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not be
13 subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a de-
14 mand for division of the question in the House or in the
15 Committee of the Whole. All points of order against such
16 further amendments are waived. After disposition of the
17 further amendments printed in the report of the Com-
18 mittee on Rules, the Committee of the Whole shall rise
19 without motion. No further consideration of the bill shall
20 be in order except pursuant to a subsequent order of the
21 House.
