## RESOLUTION

Providing for authority to initiate litigation for actions by the President or other executive branch officials inconsistent with their duties under the Constitution of the United States.

1       *Resolved*, That the Speaker is authorized to initiate  
2 or intervene in one or more civil actions on behalf of the  
3 House of Representatives in a Federal court of competent  
4 jurisdiction to seek any appropriate relief regarding the  
5 failure of the President, the head of any department or  
6 agency, or any other officer or employee of the executive  
7 branch, to act in a manner consistent with that official's  
8 duties under the Constitution and laws of the United  
9 States with respect to implementation of any provision of  
10 the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, title I or  
11 subtitle B of title II of the Health Care and Education  
12 Reconciliation Act of 2010, including any amendment  
13 made by such provision, or any other related provision of  
14 law, including a failure to implement any such provision.

15       SEC. 2. The Speaker shall notify the House of Rep-  
16 resentatives of a decision to initiate or intervene in any  
17 civil action pursuant to this resolution.

18       SEC. 3. *(a) The Office*~~The Office~~ of the General Coun-  
19 sel of the House of Representatives, at the direction of  
20 the Speaker, shall represent the House in any civil action  
21 initiated, or in which the House intervenes, pursuant to  
22 this resolution, and may employ the services of outside  
23 counsel and other experts for this purpose.

24       *(b) The chair of the Committee on House Administra-*  
25 *tion shall cause to be printed in the Congressional Record*

1 *a statement setting forth the aggregate amounts expended*  
2 *by the Office of General Counsel on outside counsel and*  
3 *other experts pursuant to subsection (a) on a quarterly*  
4 *basis. Such statement shall be submitted for printing not*  
5 *more than 30 days after the expiration of each such period.*
