RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3393) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to consolidate certain tax benefits for educational expenses, and for other purposes, and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4935) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to make improvements to the child tax credit.

- 1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
- 2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
- 3 3393) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to

1 consolidate certain tax benefits for educational expenses,
2 and for other purposes. All points of order against consid-
3 eration of the bill are waived. The amendment in the na-
4 ture of a substitute recommended by the Committee on
5 Ways and Means now printed in the bill, modified by the
6 amendment printed in the report of the Committee on
7 Rules accompanying this resolution, shall be considered as
8 adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as read.
9 All points of order against provisions in the bill, as amend-
10 ed, are waived. The previous question shall be considered
11 as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further
12 amendment thereto to final passage without intervening
13 motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and
14 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of
15 the Committee on Ways and Means; and (2) one motion
16 to recommit with or without instructions.

17 SEC. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be
18 in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 4935)
19 to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to make im-
20 provements to the child tax credit. All points of order
21 against consideration of the bill are waived. In lieu of the
22 amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by
23 the Committee on Ways and Means now printed in the
24 bill, an amendment in the nature of a substitute consisting
25 of the text of Rules Committee Print 113-54 shall be con-

1 sidered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be consid-
2 ered as read. All points of order against provisions in the
3 bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question shall
4 be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on
5 any further amendment thereto to final passage without
6 intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally
7 divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
8 member of the Committee on Ways and Means; and (2)
9 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.

10 SEC. 3. (a) In the engrossment of H.R. 3393 the
11 Clerk shall—

12 (1) add the text of H.R. 4935, as passed by the
13 House, as new matter at the end of H.R. 3393;

14 (2) conform the title of H.R. 3393 to reflect the
15 addition of H.R. 4935, as passed by the House, to
16 the engrossment;

17 (3) assign appropriate designations to provi-
18 sions within the engrossment; and

19 (4) conform provisions for short titles within
20 the engrossment.

21 (b) Upon the addition of the text of H.R. 4935, as
22 passed by the House, to the engrossment of H.R. 3393,
23 H.R. 4935 shall be laid on the table.

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
