## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4315) to amend the Endangered Species Act of 1973 to require publication on the Internet of the basis for determinations that species are endangered species or threatened species, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after adoption of this reso-  
2 lution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule  
3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of  
4 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-

1 ation of the bill (H.R. 4315) to amend the Endangered  
2 Species Act of 1973 to require publication on the Internet  
3 of the basis for determinations that species are endan-  
4 gered species or threatened species, and for other pur-  
5 poses. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with.  
6 All points of order against consideration of the bill are  
7 waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and  
8 amendments specified in this resolution and shall not ex-  
9 ceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair  
10 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Nat-  
11 ural Resources. After general debate the bill shall be con-  
12 sidered for amendment under the five-minute rule. In lieu  
13 of the amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-  
14 ommended by the Committee on Natural Resources now  
15 printed in the bill, it shall be in order to consider as an  
16 original bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-  
17 minute rule an amendment in the nature of a substitute  
18 consisting of the text of Rules Committee Print 113-55.  
19 That amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be  
20 considered as read. All points of order against that amend-  
21 ment in the nature of a substitute are waived. No amend-  
22 ment to that amendment in the nature of a substitute  
23 shall be in order except those printed in the report of the  
24 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution. Each  
25 such amendment may be offered only in the order printed

1 in the report, may be offered only by a Member designated  
2 in the report, shall be considered as read, shall be debat-  
3 able for the time specified in the report equally divided  
4 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall  
5 not be subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to  
6 a demand for division of the question in the House or in  
7 the Committee of the Whole. All points of order against  
8 such amendments are waived. At the conclusion of consid-  
9 eration of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise  
10 and report the bill to the House with such amendments  
11 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a  
12 separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted  
13 in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the amend-  
14 ment in the nature of a substitute made in order as origi-  
15 nal text. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
16 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage  
17 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit  
18 with or without instructions.
