Mr. COLE, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5230) making supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, and for other purposes; providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5272) to prohibit certain actions with respect to deferred action for aliens not lawfully present in the United States, and for other purposes; providing for consideration of the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 5021) to provide an exten-

sion of Federal-aid highway, highway safety, motor carrier safety, transit, and other programs funded out of the Highway Trust Fund, and for other purposes; and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 5230) making supplemental appropriations for the fiscal
4 year ending September 30, 2014, and for other purposes.
5 All points of order against consideration of the bill are
6 waived. The bill shall be considered as read. All points of
7 order against provisions in the bill are waived. The pre-
8 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill
9 and on any amendment thereto to final passage without
10 intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally
11 divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
12 member of the Committee on Appropriations; and (2) one
13 motion to recommit.

14 SEC. 2. After passage of H.R. 5230, and on the legis-
15 lative day of July 31, 2014, the House shall consider in
16 the House the bill (H.R. 5272) to prohibit certain actions
17 with respect to deferred action for aliens not lawfully
18 present in the United States, and for other purposes. All
19 points of order against consideration of the bill are waived.
20 The bill shall be considered as read. All points of order
21 against provisions in the bill are waived. The previous
22 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and on

1 any amendment thereto to final passage without inter-
2 vening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally di-
3 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
4 member of the Committee on the Judiciary; and (2) one
5 motion to recommit.

6 SEC. 3. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be
7 in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill (H.R.
8 5021) to provide an extension of Federal-aid highway,
9 highway safety, motor carrier safety, transit, and other
10 programs funded out of the Highway Trust Fund, and for
11 other purposes, with the Senate amendment thereto, and
12 to consider in the House, without intervention of any point
13 of order, a motion offered by the chair of the Committee
14 on Transportation and Infrastructure or his designee that
15 the House disagree to the Senate amendment. The Senate
16 amendment and the motion shall be considered as read.
17 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
18 the motion to its adoption without intervening motion ex-
19 cept one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by
20 the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee
21 on Transportation and Infrastructure.

22 SEC. 4. Any motion pursuant to clause 4 of rule XXII
23 relating to H.R. 5021 may be offered only by the Majority
24 Leader or his designee.

1 SEC. 5. It shall be in order at any time on the legisla-
2 tive day of July 31, 2014, for the Speaker to entertain
3 motions that the House suspend the rules as though under
4 clause 1 of rule XV. The Speaker or his designee shall
5 consult with the Minority Leader or her designee on the
6 designation of any matter for consideration pursuant to
7 this section.

8 SEC. 6. The requirement of clause 6(a) of rule XIII
9 for a two-thirds vote to consider a report from the Com-
10 mittee on Rules on the same day it is presented to the
11 House is waived with respect to any resolution reported
12 through the legislative day of July 31, 2014.
