Mr. SESSIONS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (S. 2244) to extend the termination date of the Terrorism Insurance Program established under the Terrorism Risk Insurance Act of 2002, and for other purposes; providing for consideration of motions to suspend the rules; and providing for proceedings during the period from December 12, 2014, through January 3, 2015.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (S.

1 2244) to extend the termination date of the Terrorism In-
2 surance Program established under the Terrorism Risk
3 Insurance Act of 2002, and for other purposes. All points
4 of order against consideration of the bill are waived. The
5 amendment in the nature of a substitute printed in the
6 report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this reso-
7 lution shall be considered as adopted. The bill, as amend-
8 ed, shall be considered as read. All points of order against
9 provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. The pre-
10 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill,
11 as amended, and on any further amendment thereto, to
12 final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one
13 hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair
14 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Finan-
15 cial Services; and (2) one motion to commit with or with-
16 out instructions.

17 SEC. 2. It shall be in order at any time on the legisla-
18 tive day of December 11, 2014, for the Speaker to enter-
19 tain motions that the House suspend the rules as though
20 under clause 1 of rule XV. The Speaker or his designee
21 shall consult with the Minority Leader or her designee on
22 the designation of any matter for consideration pursuant
23 to this section.

1 SEC. 3. On any legislative day of the second session
2 of the One Hundred Thirteenth Congress after December
3 11, 2014—

4 (a) the Journal of the proceedings of the previous day
5 shall be considered as approved; and

6 (b) the Chair may at any time declare the House ad-
7 journed to meet at a date and time, within the limits of
8 clause 4, section 5, article I of the Constitution, to be an-
9 nounced by the Chair in declaring the adjournment.

10 SEC. 4. The Speaker may appoint Members to per-
11 form the duties of the Chair for the duration of the period
12 addressed by section 3 of this resolution as though under
13 clause 8(a) of rule I.

14 SEC. 5. Each day during the period addressed by sec-
15 tion 3 of this resolution shall not constitute a calendar
16 day for purposes of section 7 of the War Powers Resolu-
17 tion (50 U.S.C. 1546).

18 SEC. 6. Each day during the period addressed by sec-
19 tion 3 of this resolution shall not constitute a legislative
20 day for purposes of clause 7 of rule XIII.
