3 **SECTION 1. FIRST LIEUTENANT ALVIN CHESTER**
4 **COCKRELL, JR. POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 130 Caldwell Drive in
7 Hazlehurst, Mississippi, shall be known and designated as

1 the “First Lieutenant Alvin Chester Cockrell, Jr. Post Of-
2 fice Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “First Lieutenant Alvin
7 Chester Cockrell, Jr. Post Office Building”.
