AN ACT

To authorize the President to extend the term of the nuclear energy agreement with the Republic of Korea until March 19, 2016.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Support for United
3 States-Republic of Korea Civil Nuclear Cooperation Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

5 Congress makes the following findings:

6 (1) In the 60th year of the alliance, the rela-
7 tionship between the United States and the Republic
8 of Korea could not be stronger. It is based on mu-
9 tual sacrifice, mutual respect, shared interests, and
10 shared responsibility to promote peace and security
11 in the Asia-Pacific region and throughout the world.

12 (2) North Korea’s nuclear weapons programs,
13 including uranium enrichment and plutonium re-
14 processing technologies, undermine security on the
15 Korean Peninsula. The United States and the Re-
16 public of Korea have a shared interest in preventing
17 further proliferation, including through the imple-
18 mentation of the 2005 Joint Statement of the Six-
19 Party Talks.

20 (3) Both the United States and Republic of
21 Korea have a shared objective in strengthening the
22 Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weap-
23 ons, done at London, Moscow, and Washington July
24 1, 1968, and a political and a commercial interest in
25 working collaboratively to address challenges to their
26 respective peaceful civil nuclear programs.

1 of the United States of America and the Government of
2 the Republic of Korea Concerning Civil Uses of Nuclear
3 Energy is submitted to Congress, the President shall pro-
4 vide to the Committee on Foreign Relations and the Com-
5 mittee on Appropriations of the Senate and the Committee
6 on Foreign Affairs and the Committee on Appropriations
7 of the House of Representatives a report on the progress
8 of negotiations on a new civil nuclear cooperation agree-
9 ment.
