A BILL

To direct the Administrator of General Services to convey
the Clifford P. Hansen Federal Courthouse back to
Teton County, Wyoming.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Clifford P. Hansen
5 Federal Courthouse Conveyance Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

7 In this Act:

1 (1) ADMINISTRATOR.—The term “Adminis-
2 trator” means the Administrator of General Serv-
3 ices.

4 (2) COUNTY.—The term “County” means
5 Teton County, Wyoming.

6 **SEC. 3. CONVEYANCE OF FEDERAL COURTHOUSE TO**
7 **TETON COUNTY, WYOMING.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
9 sion of law, the Administrator shall convey to the County,
10 without consideration, all right, title, and interest of the
11 United States in and to the building and site located at
12 145 East Simpson Street, Jackson, Wyoming, known as
13 the “Clifford P. Hansen Federal Courthouse”.

14 (b) ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS.—The Secretary shall
15 require the County to pay all survey costs and other ad-
16 ministrative costs necessary for the conveyance required
17 under subsection (a).

18 (c) APPLICATION OF OTHER LAWS.—The conveyance
19 under subsection (a) is not subject to the provisions of
20 the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act (42 U.S.C.
21 11301 et seq.).
