AN ACT

To reauthorize the United States Anti-Doping Agency, and
for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “United States Anti-
3 Doping Agency Reauthorization Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. PROHIBIT PERFORMANCE-ENHANCING METHODS.**

5 Section 701 of title VII of the Office of National
6 Drug Control Policy Reauthorization Act of 2006 (21
7 U.S.C. 2001) is amended—

8 (1) in subsection (a), by striking paragraph (4);

9 and

10 (2) in subsection (b)—

11 (A) in paragraph (1), by inserting “and be
12 recognized worldwide as the independent na-
13 tional anti-doping organization for the United
14 States” after “Committee”;

15 (B) in paragraph (2), by striking “, or per-
16 formance-enhancing genetic modifications ac-
17 complished through gene-doping” and inserting
18 “or prohibited performance-enhancing methods
19 adopted by the Agency”;

20 (C) in paragraph (3), by striking “, or per-
21 formance-enhancing genetic modifications ac-
22 complished through gene-doping” and inserting
23 “or prohibited performance-enhancing methods
24 adopted by the Agency”;

25 (D) in paragraph (4), by striking “and the
26 prevention of use of performance-enhancing

1 drugs, or performance-enhancing genetic modi-
 2 fications accomplished through gene-doping by
 3 United States amateur athletes; and” and in-
 4 serting “, and the prevention of use by United
 5 States amateur athletes of performance-enhanc-
 6 ing drugs or prohibited performance-enhancing
 7 methods adopted by the Agency.”; and

8 (E) by striking paragraph (5).

9 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

10 Section 703 of title VII of the Office of National
 11 Drug Control Policy Reauthorization Act of 2006 (21
 12 U.S.C. 2003) is amended to read as follows:

13 **“SEC. 703. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

14 “There are authorized to be appropriated to the
 15 United States Anti-Doping Agency—

16 “(1) for fiscal year 2014, \$11,300,000;

17 “(2) for fiscal year 2015, \$11,700,000;

18 “(3) for fiscal year 2016, \$12,300,000;

19 “(4) for fiscal year 2017, \$12,900,000;

20 “(5) for fiscal year 2018, \$13,500,000;

21 “(6) for fiscal year 2019, \$14,100,000; and

1 “(7) for fiscal year 2020, \$14,800,000.”.
