## A BILL

To prohibit trespassing on critical infrastructure used in or affecting interstate commerce to commit a criminal offense.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TRESPASSING ON CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE**

4 **USED IN OR AFFECTING INTERSTATE COM-**

5 **MERCE TO COMMIT CRIME.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 65 of title 18, United  
7 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
8 lowing:

1 **“§ 1370. Trespassing on critical infrastructure used in**  
2 **or affecting interstate commerce to com-**  
3 **mit crime**

4 “(a) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term ‘critical  
5 infrastructure’—

6 “(1) means physical systems and assets so vital  
7 to the United States that the incapacity or destruc-  
8 tion of such systems and assets would have a debili-  
9 tating impact on security, national economic secu-  
10 rity, national public health or safety, or any com-  
11 bination of those matters; and

12 “(2) includes a landmark, structure, or other  
13 object—

14 “(A) declared to be a national monument  
15 under section 2 of the Act of June 8, 1906  
16 (commonly known as the ‘Antiquities Act of  
17 1906’) (16 U.S.C. 431); or

18 “(B) established as a national monument  
19 by an Act of Congress.

20 “(b) PROHIBITION.—It shall be unlawful to know-  
21 ingly go upon on any critical infrastructure used in or af-  
22 fecting interstate commerce, with intent to commit a  
23 criminal offense.

24 “(c) PENALTY.—Any person who violates subsection  
25 (b) shall be fined under this title or imprisoned for not  
26 more than 5 years, or both.”.

1           (b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—  
2 The table of sections for chapter 65 of title 18, United  
3 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
4 lowing:

“1370. Trespassing on critical infrastructure used in or affecting interstate com-  
merce to commit crime.”.
