Ms. MURKOWSKI introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To establish a maximum amount for special use permit fees applicable to certain cabins on National Forest System land in the State of Alaska.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Alaska Subsistence
5 Structure Protection Act of 2013”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

7 In this Act:

8 (1) COVERED CABIN.—The term “covered
9 cabin” means a cabin (including related structures)

1 on National Forest System land in the State of
2 Alaska—

3 (A) that is used for subsistence uses;

4 (B) that is subject to section 1303(d) of
5 the Alaska National Interest Lands Conserva-
6 tion Act (16 U.S.C. 3193(d));

7 (C) that is subject to section 1316(a) of
8 the Alaska National Interest Lands Conserva-
9 tion Act (16 U.S.C. 3204(a)); or

10 (D) that is used for commercial fishing by
11 a permittee that does not generate more than
12 \$15,000 in gross annual income from the fish-
13 ery.

14 (2) **SUBSISTENCE USES.**—The term “subsist-
15 ence uses” has the meaning given the term in sec-
16 tion 803 of the Alaska National Interest Lands Con-
17 servation Act (16 U.S.C. 3113).

18 **SEC. 3. ALASKA SUBSISTENCE USE CABIN PERMIT FEES.**

19 The maximum amount of the fee for the issuance of
20 a special use permit by the Secretary of Agriculture for
21 the use and occupancy of National Forest System land
22 for a covered cabin shall be not more than \$250.
