3 **SECTION 1. USE OF EMANCIPATION HALL FOR THE UN-**
4 **VEILING OF FREDERICK DOUGLASS STATUE.**

5 (a) **AUTHORIZATION.**—Emancipation Hall in the
6 Capitol Visitor Center is authorized to be used for an
7 event on June 19, 2013, to unveil a statue of Frederick
8 Douglass.

9 (b) **PREPARATIONS.**—Physical preparations for the
10 conduct of the event described in subsection (a) shall be
11 carried out in accordance with such conditions as may be
12 prescribed by the Architect of the Capitol.
