Mrs. MILLER of Michigan submitted the following concurrent resolution; which
was referred to the Committee on House Administration

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the reprinting of the 25th edition of the pocket
version of the United States Constitution.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. POCKET VERSION OF THE UNITED STATES**
4 **CONSTITUTION.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The 25th edition of the pocket
6 version of the United States Constitution shall be re-
7 printed as a House document under the direction of the
8 Joint Committee on Printing.

9 (b) ADDITIONAL COPIES.—In addition to the usual
10 number, there shall be printed the lesser of—

1 (1) 285,400 copies of the document, of which
2 235,400 copies shall be for the use of the House of
3 Representatives and 50,000 copies shall be for the
4 use of the Senate; or

5 (2) such number of copies of the document as
6 does not exceed a total production and printing cost
7 of \$135,312, with distribution to be allocated in the
8 same proportion as described in paragraph (1), ex-
9 cept that in no case shall the number of copies be
10 less than 1 per Member of Congress.

11 (c) DISTRIBUTION.—The copies of the document re-
12 printed for the use of the House and the Senate under
13 subsection (a) shall be distributed in accordance with—

14 (1) a distribution plan approved by the chair
15 and ranking minority member of the Committee on
16 House Administration of the House of Representa-
17 tives, in the case of the copies printed for the use
18 of the House; and

19 (2) a distribution plan approved by the chair
20 and ranking minority member of the Committee on
21 Rules and Administration of the Senate, in the case
22 of the copies printed for the use of the Senate.
