1 **SECTION 1. STAFF SERGEANT ROBERT H. DIETZ POST OF-**
2 **FICE BUILDING.**

3 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
4 Postal Service located at 90 Cornell Street in Kingston,
5 New York, shall be known and designated as the “Staff
6 Sergeant Robert H. Dietz Post Office Building”.

7 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
8 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
9 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
10 be deemed to be a reference to the “Staff Sergeant Robert
11 H. Dietz Post Office Building”.
