Mr. MILLER of Florida introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend title 36, United States Code, to make certain improvements in the congressional charter of the Disabled American Veterans.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONGRESSIONAL CHARTER OF DISABLED**
4 **AMERICAN VETERANS.**

5 (a) PURPOSES.—Section 50302 of title 36, United
6 States Code, is amended—

7 (1) in the matter preceding paragraph (1), by
8 striking “The purposes of the corporation are” and
9 inserting “The corporation is organized exclusively

1 for charitable and educational purposes. The pur-
2 poses of the corporation shall include—”;

3 (2) in paragraph (6), by striking “and” at the
4 end;

5 (3) by redesignating paragraph (7) as para-
6 graph (9); and

7 (4) by inserting after paragraph (6) the fol-
8 lowing new paragraphs:

9 “(7) to educate the public about the sacrifices
10 and needs of disabled veterans;

11 “(8) to educate disabled veterans about the
12 benefits and resources available to them; and”.

13 (b) DISSOLUTION.—Chapter 503 of such title is
14 amended by adding at the end the following new section:

15 **“§ 50309. Dissolution**

16 “On dissolution or final liquidation of the corpora-
17 tion, any assets remaining after the discharge or satisfac-
18 tory provision for the discharge of all liabilities shall be
19 transferred to the Secretary of Veterans Affairs for the
20 care of disabled veterans.”.

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
