A BILL

To designate the Federal building and United States courthouse located at 83 Meeting Street in Charleston, South Carolina, as the “J. Waties Waring Judicial Center”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. J. WATIES WARING FEDERAL BUILDING AND**
4 **UNITED STATES COURTHOUSE.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The Federal building and United
6 States courthouse located at 83 Meeting Street in Charles-
7 ton, South Carolina, shall be known and designated as the
8 “J. Waties Waring Judicial Center”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the Federal building and United States court-
4 house referred to in subsection (a) shall be deemed to be
5 a reference to the “J. Waties Waring Judicial Center”.
