2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT AND IM-**
4 **PLEMENTATION GRANTS AUTHORIZATION.**

5 Section 406(b) of the Federal Water Pollution Con-
6 trol Act (33 U.S.C. 1346(b)) is amended by adding at the
7 end the following new paragraph:

1 “(5) REPEAL OF AUTHORITY.—The Adminis-
2 trator may not make a grant to a State or local gov-
3 ernment under this subsection after the date of en-
4 actment of this paragraph.”.
