A BILL

To extend by 15 years the authority of the Secretary of Commerce to conduct the quarterly financial report program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Quarterly Financial
5 Report Reauthorization Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY FOR SECRETARY OF**
7 **COMMERCE TO CONDUCT QUARTERLY FI-**
8 **NANCIAL REPORT PROGRAM.**

9 Section 4(b) of the Act entitled “An Act to amend
10 title 13, United States Code, to transfer responsibility for
11 the quarterly financial report from the Federal Trade
12 Commission to the Secretary of Commerce, and for other
13 purposes”, approved January 12, 1983 (Public Law 97–
14 454; 13 U.S.C. 91 note), is amended by striking “2015”
15 and inserting “2030”.
