A BILL

To direct the Federal Aviation Administration to allow certain construction or alteration of structures by State departments of transportation without requiring an aeronautical study, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Airport Construction
5 and Alteration Reform Act of 2016”.

1 **SEC. 2. COMPLETION OF CERTAIN PROJECTS BY STATE DE-**
2 **PARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.**

3 With respect to a proposed construction or alteration
4 for which notice to the Federal Aviation Administration
5 is required under section 77.9 of title 14, Code of Federal
6 Regulations, upon such notice, the Administrator of the
7 Federal Aviation Administration shall allow a State de-
8 partment of transportation to carry out such construction
9 or alteration, and shall not require an aeronautical study
10 under section 77.27 of such title, if such State department
11 of transportation—

- 12 (1) has appropriate engineering expertise to
13 perform the construction or alteration; and
14 (2) complies with applicable Federal Aviation
15 Administration standards for the construction or al-
16 teration.

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
