A BILL

To amend title 54, United States Code, to provide for congressional and State approval of national monuments and restrictions on the use of national monuments.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Monument
5 Designation Transparency and Accountability Act of
6 2015”.

7 **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF NATIONAL MONUMENTS.**

8 Section 320301 of title 54, United States Code, is
9 amended—

1 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “The Presi-
2 dent may” and inserting “After obtaining congres-
3 sional approval of the proposed national monument,
4 certifying compliance with the National Environ-
5 mental Policy Act of 1969 (42 U.S.C. 4321 et seq.)
6 with respect to the proposed national monument,
7 and determining that the State in which the pro-
8 posed national monument is to be located has en-
9 acted legislation approving the designation of the
10 proposed national monument, the President may”;
11 and

12 (2) by adding at the end the following:

13 “(e) RESTRICTIONS ON PUBLIC USE.—The Secretary
14 shall not implement any restrictions on the public use of
15 a national monument until the expiration of an appro-
16 priate review period (as determined by the Secretary) pro-
17 viding for public input and congressional approval.”.

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
