RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3009) to amend section 241(i) of the Immigration and Nationality Act to deny assistance under such section to a State or political subdivision of a State that prohibits its officials from taking certain actions with respect to immigration.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 3009) to amend section 241(i) of the Immigration and
4 Nationality Act to deny assistance under such section to
5 a State or political subdivision of a State that prohibits

1 its officials from taking certain actions with respect to im-
2 migration. All points of order against consideration of the
3 bill are waived. The bill shall be considered as read. All
4 points of order against provisions in the bill are waived.
5 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
6 the bill and on any amendment thereto to final passage
7 without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate
8 equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking
9 minority member of the Committee on the Judiciary; and
10 (2) one motion to recommit.

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
