A BILL

To establish authorization levels for general business loans
for fiscal years 2015 and 2016.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Small Business Lend-
5 ing Reauthorization Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. GENERAL BUSINESS LOANS AUTHORIZATION.**

7 Section 20 of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 631
8 note) is amended—

9 (1) by redesignating subsection (j) as sub-
10 section (f); and

1 (2) by adding at the end the following:

2 “(g) FISCAL YEAR 2015.—For fiscal year 2015, the
3 Administrator is authorized to make \$20,500,000,000 in
4 general business loans, as provided in section 7(a).

5 “(h) FISCAL YEAR 2016.—For fiscal year 2016, the
6 Administrator is authorized to make \$23,500,000,000 in
7 general business loans, as provided in section 7(a).”.

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
