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## A BILL

2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Ensuring Access to  
5       Clinical Trials Act of 2015”.

6       **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF SUNSET PROVISION.**

7       Effective as if included in the enactment of the Im-  
8       proving Access to Clinical Trials Act of 2009 (Public Law

1 111–255, 124 Stat. 2640), section 3 of that Act is amend-  
2 ed by striking subsection (e).

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
