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**A BILL**

To extend by 15 years the authority of the Secretary of Commerce to conduct the quarterly financial report program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Quarterly Financial  
5 Reporting Reauthorization Act of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. FIFTEEN-YEAR EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY FOR**  
2 **SECRETARY OF COMMERCE TO CONDUCT**  
3 **THE QUARTERLY FINANCIAL REPORT PRO-**  
4 **GRAMS.**

5 Section 4(b) of the Act entitled “An Act to amend  
6 title 13, United States Code, to transfer responsibility for  
7 the quarterly financial report from the Federal Trade  
8 Commission to the Secretary of Commerce, and for other  
9 purposes”, approved January 12, 1983 (13 U.S.C. 91  
10 note), is amended by striking “2015” and inserting  
11 “2030”.

12 **SEC. 3. REPORT ON DATA SECURITY PROCEDURES OF THE**  
13 **BUREAU OF THE CENSUS.**

14 (a) *REVIEW.*—*The Secretary of Commerce shall con-*  
15 *duct a review of the data security procedures of the Bureau*  
16 *of the Census, including such procedures that have been im-*  
17 *plemented since that data breach of systems of the Office*  
18 *of Personnel Management that occurred during fiscal year*  
19 *2015.*

20 (b) *REPORT.*—

21 (1) *REQUIREMENT.*—*Not later than 90 days*  
22 *after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-*  
23 *retary shall submit to the Committee on Homeland*  
24 *Security and Governmental Affairs of the Senate and*  
25 *the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform*

1       *of the House of Representatives a report on the review*  
2       *required by subsection (a).*

3               (2) *CONTENTS.—The report required by para-*  
4       *graph (1) shall—*

5                       (A) *identify all information systems of the*  
6                       *Bureau of the Census that contain sensitive in-*  
7                       *formation;*

8                       (B) *described any actions carried out by the*  
9                       *Secretary of Commerce or the Director of the Bu-*  
10                      *reau of the Census to secure sensitive informa-*  
11                      *tion that have been implemented since that data*  
12                      *breach of systems of the Office of Personnel Man-*  
13                      *agement that occurred during fiscal year 2015;*

14                      (C) *identify any known data breaches of in-*  
15                      *formation systems of the Bureau of the Census*  
16                      *that contain sensitive information; and*

17                      (D) *identify whether the Bureau of the Cen-*  
18                      *sus stores any information that, if combined*  
19                      *with other such information, would comprise*  
20                      *classified information.*

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
